**Credit Transfer Package for NSW TAFE 2008 Revised**

Under the credit transfer scheme detailed below, students enrolling in the Bachelor of Arts in Communication (Information and Media) with the *Associate Diploma in Library Practice* or the *Diploma in Library and Information Services* (completed no more than seven years ago) are eligible to apply for exemption from the subjects listed below.

Students who have partially completed the **Associate Diploma** or **Diploma** may apply for exemption from certain subjects in the Bachelor of Arts in Communication (Information and Media).

Students eligible for the complete package will receive exemption for 52 credit points from a total of 144 credit points which is equivalent to one year of full-time study. The full list of compulsory and elective subjects in the Bachelor of Arts in Communication (Information and Media) is provided in the online entry in the *Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences Handbook*. In summary:

**\*Notes on Electives**
