*Credit Transfer Package for Temasek Polytechnic, Singapore*

Under the credit transfer scheme detailed below, students enrolling in the Bachelor of Arts in Communication (Journalism) who have completed the *Diploma in Communications and Media Management* at Temasek Polytechnic with a GPA of 5.0/7 or better are eligible to apply for exemption from the subjects listed below.

Students eligible for the package will receive exemption for 48 credit points which is equivalent to one year of full time study.
